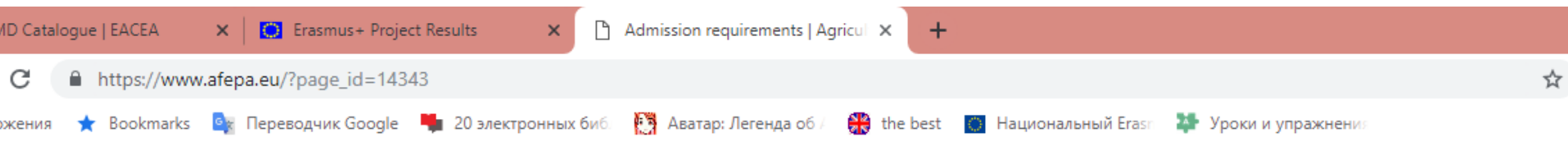

To be admitted to the ERASMUS Mundus Master's Programme in Agricultural, Food and Environmental Policy Analysis candidates need to have:

- A **Bachelor's degree** or an equivalent academic degree of minimum three years of undergraduate study corresponding to 180 ECTS credits with a grade of at least an average "B" grade or equivalent grade. Students in their final year of their Bachelor's degree may be provisionally admitted in the AFEPA Master's programme on the condition that their Bachelor's degree is awarded before they enrol the programme.
- A **minimum of 24 (ECTS) in economics** – including management, mathematics, and

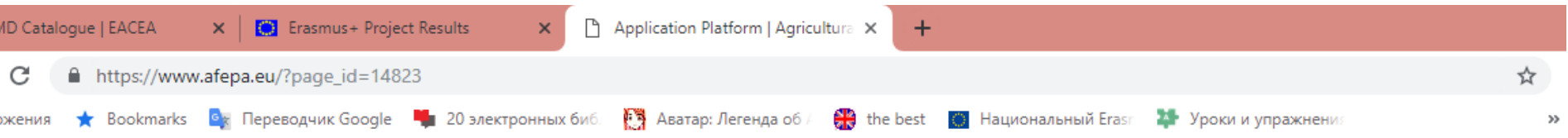

 - Online application form.
 - Motivation letter (the number of words and parameters of the letter are described in the requirements of the program)
 - Diploma(s)
 - Transcript of records
 - 2 Letter of recommendation
 - Language certificate
 - Any available certificates of professional qualifications (not work experience). This is optional.
 - Copy of passport
 - Residence certificate
 - **All documents must be officially translated and certified by a notary**

Tuition fee	Up to 9.000 € per year	Up to 4500 € per year
Travel costs*	2000 € per year if the place of residence is less than 4000 km from the EM JMD coordinator 3000 € per year if the residence is 4000 km or more from the EM JMD coordinator	1000 € per year
Accommodation costs*	1000 €	-
Living allowance (max 24 month)	1000 € per month (when the person is not in the country of permanent residence , and not more than 3 months in any Partner Country)	1000 € per month (when the person is not in the country of permanent residence)



* The amount of the scholarship for travel / accommodation costs depends on the place of residence at the time of application for the scholarship

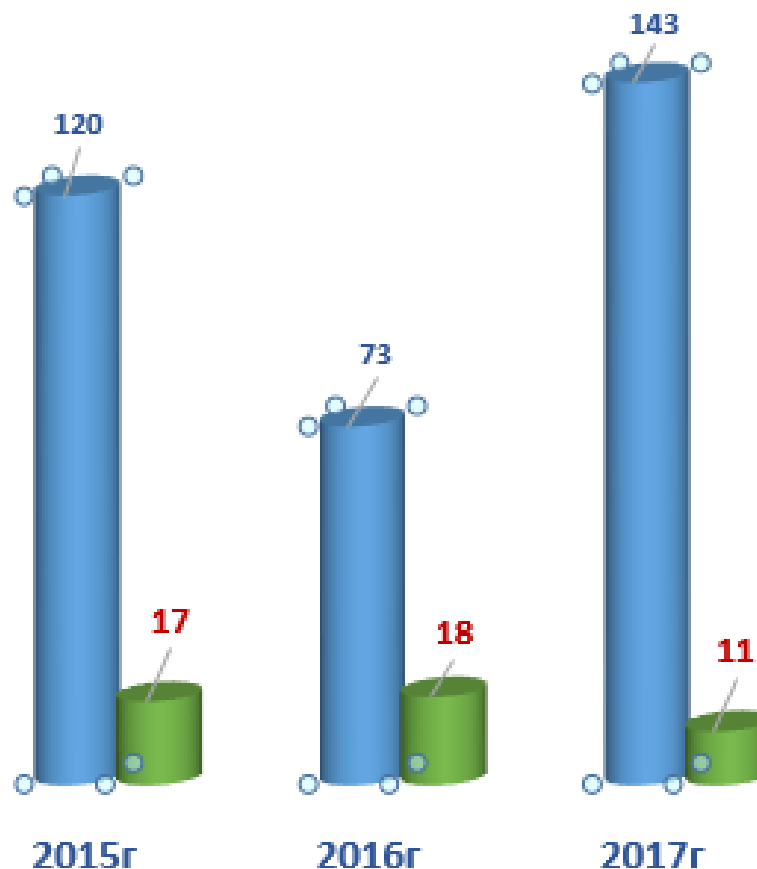
■ Total applications ■ Students awarded by the scholarship

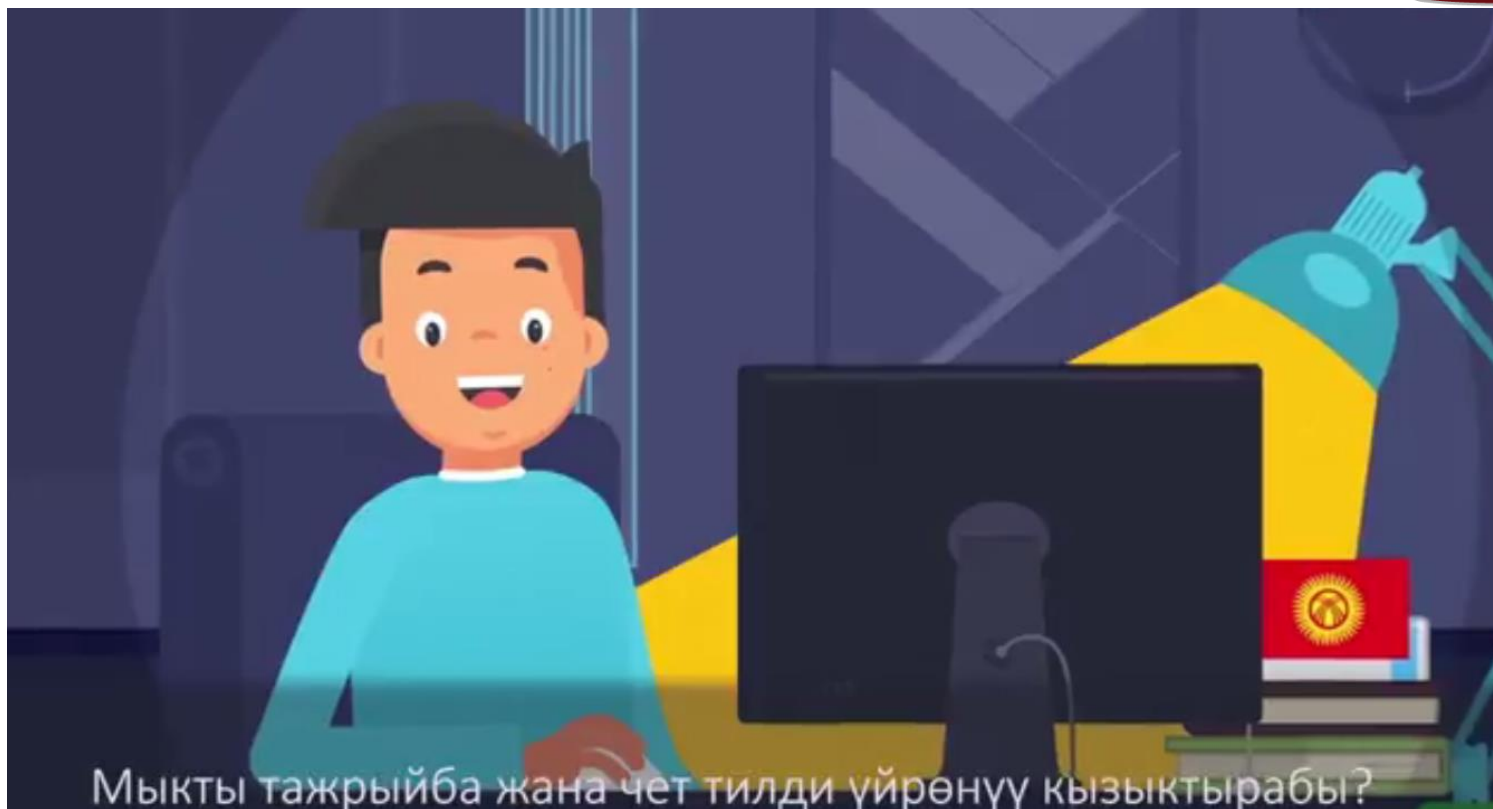
