- 3. **Promote Collaborative Approaches:** Encourage joint initiatives, peer learning, and cross-institutional cooperation to build synergy across different aspects of the Bologna Process in Kyrgyzstan.

### **Expected Outputs**

- **Roadmap for QA Improvement:** Recommendations and action plans for HEIs and accreditation agencies to enhance QA in line with ESG.
- **Policy Recommendations:** Draft proposals for policymakers and institutional leaders to address gaps in QA, recognition, and mobility, including potential regulatory reforms and capacity-building initiatives.
- **Networking and Collaboration:** Strengthened links among Kyrgyz HEIs, accreditation bodies, student representatives, and international experts, fostering future cooperative projects and reforms.
