



Three basic goals



- the creation of a support mechanism for 'the study programmes accreditation of Russian HEIs in international associations'


Overall ranking for destination countries

Russian QA Framework for Higher Education (Levels)







State accreditation for the quality of education

- 1992 r. the term 'accreditation' appeared in the Russian Law on Education
- 1997 r. introduction of a bundle: state educational standard state accreditation state diploma
- 2000 r. procedure of the state accreditation becomes mandatory for all educational institutions every five years
- 2003 r. Russia joined the Bologna Process with a developed system of "quality assurance", including state licensing, certification and accreditation



Partnership of State and Public Accreditation

- The market economy supports diversity
- The possibility of public and professional accreditation is specified in the law of 1992.
- Public and professional accreditation in the sleeping state till 2000th years
- 2000 the ENQA network is created
- 2005 the translation of the ENQA standards into Russian by Rosakkredagentstvom
- 2005 emergence of the ESG standards
- 2003-2010 enthusiasm for Russian universities to create quality management systems based on ISO, EFQM, TQM, national developments (LETI, RUDN),
- 2008 Rosakredagentstvo becomes a member of ENQA





Monitoring System for Public and Professional Accreditation

- Informational support of professional and public accreditation of study programmes, as well as mechanisms for collecting, processing and uploading accreditation results
- Unites 89 accrediting organizations
- Contains a list of 2300 accredited programmes of vocational and higher education



Why Public and Professional Accreditation?

— Industrial Benefits

- Coordination of mechanisms for ensuring the quality of education for industry needs and between sectors
- Reflection of industry's public opinion
- Consolidation of opinions when working with the state
- The mechanism of interaction within the industry
- Creating favorable interactions within and between sectors
- Coordination of business activities
- Promoting the development of companies and building advanced market relations in Russia



Why Public and Professional Accreditation?

— Methodical Benefits

- institutional approach to professional and public accreditation for assessing the quality of education
- Development of normative documents and regulating procedures for professional and public accreditation and conducting accreditation expertise
- Expert review
- Legal protection
- Assistance in the development of occupational standards

Russian Public Accreditation Agencies follow ESG ENQA 2002 r. Association for Engineering Education of Russia (AEER) follow ESG ENQA and is a member of ENAEE with the EUR-ACE Accord

2005 r. Russian Independent Evaluation and Accreditation Agency in the Sphere of Higher education (AKKORK) – full member of ENQA and "acts in accordance with" ESG ENQA

2010 r. National Centre for Public Accreditation (NCPA) – "Objective No.1 – Develop and implement quality standards for programmes of higher education in compliance with ESG-ENQA"

Russian Public Accreditation Agencies promote QA Principles in compliance with ESG-ENQA

Higher education institutions have primary responsibility for the quality of their provision and its assurance

Quality assurance responds to the diversity of higher education systems, institutions, programmes and students

Quality assurance supports the development of a quality culture

Quality assurance takes into account the needs and expectations of students, all other stakeholders and society
