Recommendations for creating sustainability education at the university level

- Promoting the use of green travel. More sustainable travel
- Working on reducing the environmental footprint of laboratory research or fostering the green use of shared research infrastructures
- Addressing recycling and waste management, sustainable construction and renovation, physical greening of the campus
- Engaging with partner institutions and student groups and organisations and going international
- Setting up strategies including concrete goals, targets and indicators to monitor progress on greening
